IDEA regulations require all students to participate in District and Statewide assessments. Selected Special Education Students are eligible to be assessed using the Idaho Alternate-ISAT Assessment (I-PASS). Eligibility for the Alt-ISAT is defined by the State Department of Education and considered by student IEP teams. Current information will be administered one time per year in the spring for all studen
