

Earn College Credit While Attending High School!

Through agreements with Idaho community colleges, Boise School District high school students may receive college credit while taking classes at the Dennis Technical Education Center or a professional-technical (PTE) class at a home high school. Qualified credits apply toward technical certificates, Associate of Applied Science degrees, and/or Bachelor of Applied Science degrees. Students can purchase these credits at minimal cost. Credits are entered onto a college transcript, making them easily transferable to other institutions. Costs and registration processes vary depending on the institution offering the credit.

Why enroll in a tech prep program?

- Save on college expense
- Avoid course duplication from high school to college
- Shorten time needed to earn a technical certificate or college degree
- Earn college credit for approved courses
- Transition easily from high school to college to career

How to earn credits?

- Enroll in an approved Tech Prep PTE program through your high school instructor
- Earn a "B" or better in your approved high school course based upon college criteria
- Maintain a high school cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher
