SUMMER MUSIC CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Choir: The Summer Music Choir is for students from the 4th through 12th grade who are interested in refining and improving their vocal skills.

Beginning Strings/Band: The beginning level instrumental classes are designed to start students who have no previous playing experience and who will be eligible for an instrumental class in the fall. This class will provide the basic skills necessary for your child to get off on the right foot and ready for their school band or orchestra.

Intermediate Strings/Band : The intermediate classes are for those young musicians who have just completed their first year in the school band or orchestra program. This class will help your child improve upon the skills acquired during the school year.

Advanced Strings/Band: The concert level classes are designed for those students who have two or more years playing experience and are motivated to continue their music education in the summer months. The class will be challenging and worthwhile.
