Boise School Levy Facts—Tuesday, March 13

What has the Boise School District done to reduce spending?

To deal with massive cuts in funding from the state Legislature, the District has made accountable cuts totaling \$22 million over the past three years, including \$6 million in administrative positions like assistant principals and school counselors, and instituting unpaid furlough days for staff to save another \$2.1 million. Those cuts shielded the classrooms, which have been unaffected. 100 percent of the money raised through the levy would go toward preserving class sizes and educational programs, not on administrative costs.
