Art Parents	Teach art in classrooms throughout school year. Organize and provide support at the annual Art Fair/Silent Auction (May).
Babysitting	Coordinate student babysitters for meetings and school events.

Donations	Solicit donations from community throughout school year.

Liberty Pride	Assist with monthly lunches for students and monthly school spirit days throughout the school year. Assist with selection and sale of Liberty sportswear.
Membership and Volunteers	Assist with annual membership drives (September and January) and solicitation of members throughout the school year. Volunteer to assist with Special Events (picture days, testing) throughout the school year.
Music Program	Assist with music programs throughout the school year.
Reflections	Assist with national PTA-sponsored art program for student works (Fall).
School Directory	Assist with creation and sale of student/family directory. Solicit advertising. (September)
Student/family events	Assist at family events and students-only events throughout the school year.
Staff Appreciation	Assist with "appreciation" events for teachers and staff throughout the school year.
