Boise Levy Fact

Why is the Boise School District seeking a \$14 million per year, five-year levy?

“Boise’s nationally recognized schools have sustained three years of devastating state funding cuts, along with significant losses in local property tax revenue. As a result, the District faces a projected ongoing deficit of \$14 million beginning in 2012-2013. To balance the budget, voters in the Boise School District will be asked on March 13 to approve a temporary, five-year school levy of \$14 million per year. The cost to the average homeowner in Boise would be about \$7 per month.”
