7th Grade Pre-Registration for South Junior High:

Wednesday, February 8th, 7:00 to 8:00 p.m. – South Junior High Parent Open House. Please mark your calendar! This is a great opportunity for you, Mom and Dad, to see South Jr High School, hear from the South building administration team and meet the 7th grade teachers & elective teachers. Programs, electives and extra-curricular opportunities will be explored.

Friday, February 10th - PARENTS - if you choose, you may sign up to meet with me, David Grapp, Monroe School Counselor, for ½ hour time slots to discuss transition planning, course selection, concerns or questions you may have. You can email me to request a time at david.grapp@boiseschools.org or if another day works better please just ask for an appointment time that best meets your needs.

Thursday, February 23rd - 7th grade On-Line Pre-Registration through Infinite Campus will be done at South Junior High in the computer lab. Students will meet the South Jr High School Counselors, choose his/her elective classes and register for them on-line on this day. You will be able to log into Infinite Campus, Student Portal, at home if you would like to view/change your child's elective selections - but please note students will choose electives on this day.

Fourth Quarter - Accelerated placement decisions are made through test scores, teacher recommendations, 6th grade grades and student interest.

During the Summer - You will receive a Newsletter from South with all that you will need to know about picking up your schedule, practicing your locker combination, start dates of athletic opportunities, and more! You also will need to get your physical, completed anytime after May 1st of the 6th grade year or over the summer and turn it into South in August for PE & athletic opportunities! South will provide more information so your student can easily meet this requirement.

Note on Open Enrollment: If you move out of the South area between now and the beginning of 7th grade, you will need to apply for open enrollment. If you currently do not live in the South attendance area and wish to apply for open enrollment, please ask the school or visit the District website, www.boiseschools.org for questions regarding the Open Enrollment process.
